# A knight to remember

#### **Bourell honored at CIRP Conference**

Blown away.

Those are the words Dr. David Bourell, professor emeritus at The University of Texas at Austin, used to describe his reaction to being named a Knight of Laser Technology at the 13<sup>th</sup> CIRP Conference on Photonic Technologies in Furth, Germany on Sept. 16.

"The notification came as a complete surprise," Bourell said. "I have worked with lasers as a tool in additive manufacturing for over 30 years, but I really wouldn't consider myself to be a laser expert."

The award recognizes the international career accomplishments in areas related to laser technology. Bourell is the 11<sup>th</sup> Knight since the inauguration of the award in 1997. His contributions are in the area of additive manufacturing, specifically laser sinter of metals, ceramics

and polymers. He was the first person to use additive manufacturing (AM) to create a fully metal part in 1990, which is now a mainstay of the technology. He holds 14 patents, most dealing with materials innovations in Laser Sintering, an additive manufacturing process.

#### More honors ahead

Bourell has been a member of the Minerals, Metals, and Materials Society for over 40 years.

"I've been involved at many levels, from symposium organizer and committee member through a three-year rotation on the Society Board of Directors" he said. "I am a Fellow of the 14,000-member Society, and by rule, there can be no more than 100 TMS Fellows at any point in time. In March of next year in Las Vegas, I will be honored at a TMS symposium organized in my name."

#### High School Director Report - Tim Orsak

- 88 schools and 960 students were in attendance at the 2024 High School State Meet.
- Separate senior testing rooms at State were discussed, and it was suggested that senior testing rooms not be separated by classification

#### Middle School Director Report – Ernesto Rivera

- 161 eligible schools were in attendance.
- More hall monitors are needed upstairs.
- It was suggested that we use Remind 101 or a similar app for future State Meets to improve communication in case of any emergency notifications.

#### Treasurer - Sheri Woodall

Board members were given the budget to review. Sheri reported the budget looks good at this point.

#### Executive Director Report -Julie Majewski-Smith

- Reported that 184 high schools 203 middle schools/ elementaries have memberships.
- Executive Director was given permission to offer starter/introductory packages to whole districts an incentive to promote entire district participation.
- Dallas ISD summary Total 105 schools (17 HS, 32 MS, 8 NS/EL and 48 EL). DISD purchases each school



Action Item: Test Pool Cost – Increases to HS and MS test pool fees from \$50/ event to \$55/event were approved to offset test writer salary increases approved in March.

Action Item: High School State Meet Entry Fees – Board approved the increase of the High School State meet entry fee to \$10 per event to maintain the scholarships at their current level.

Action Item: Policy update for using TMSCA program at invitational meets - The Board approved the requirement that schools using the TMSCA program for a meet must have a current membership and must follow the requirement

that only TMSCA member schools may participate, i.e. there is no individual participation.

Action Item: Policy update about school coach for TMSCA membership – The Board approved a requirement that the primary coach listed on the form to be a school employee for membership in TMSCA even if the actual team is run by parent(s)/volunteer(s). This will help ensure that the school has given permission to use the school's name when entering TMSCA events.

## A synopsis of TMSCA's 4 contests

#### **Number Sense**

Number Sense involves a 10-minute, 80-question mental math test covering all high school mathematics courses. Shortcuts need to be developed and practiced in order to compete and finish the test.

#### **Science**

This contest challenges students to do a wide range of reading in biology, chemistry and physics, to gain an understanding of the significance of experiments rather than to recall details, to be alert to new discoveries and information in the areas of science, to gain an understanding of the basic principles as well as knowledge of the history and philosophy of science, and to foster a sense of enthusiasm about how science affects our lives.

#### **Calculator Applications**

This contest includes calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, roots, powers, exponential, logarithms, trigonometric functions and inverse trigonometric functions. In addition to straightforward calculation

problems, the contest includes geometric and stated problems similar to those found in algebra, geometry and trigonometry textbooks, previous contests and League materials related to the contest.

#### **Mathematics**

This contest is designed to test knowledge and understanding in the areas of algebra I and algebra II, geometry, trigonometry, math analysis, analytic geometry, pre-calculus and elementary calculus.

use. Bourell was instrumental in starting this process.

"In 2008, I was part of a group of about 15 people who met at ASTM headquarters in West Conshohocken, Pennsylvania," he said. "We organized a 'constitutional convention' at the same location in January 2009, attended by about 100 stakeholders. At that meeting, the ASTM F42 Committee on Additive Manufacturing was formed. I've served for about 10 years on the Terminology Subcommittee International."

#### Staying involved

When Bourell retired from UT two years ago after serving 43 years on the faculty, he was given emeritus status. He has no official duties with the university but keeps busy with a few other professional activities. For over 20 years, he has been a member of the Materials and Metallurgy Professional Engineering Exam Committee with an organization called the NCEES.

"Basically, engineers in the US can become registered professionally," he said. "It's somewhat like CPAs in accounting or doctors. There is a series of tests that applicants take. One such test is advanced and discipline-specific. The one dealing with materials and metallurgy has a national committee of about 30 people who actually create exam problems and the exam itself. This is the committee that I belong to. I've been through the officer rotation of this committee several times over the years."

#### Calculator testing

Bourell began working with TMSCA in the early 1980s. He writes four Calculator Applications tests for TMSCA every year. One of these is used for the State Meet.

"I also provide TMSCA with test tops," he said. "These are the number crunch problems that are relatively straight forward for me to generate, but they are rather tedious for others to create."

The UIL Calculator Applications test was created in 1981 by John Cogdell, a professor in the Electrical and Computing Engineering Department at The University of Texas at Austin.

"The contest was an outgrowth of the

old Slide Rule Contest," Bourell said. "Back in those days, there were nine student activities conferences in the fall. John was rather overwhelmed with so much travel, so he invited me to join, in part to split up the travel."

Bourell went to his first event, a student activities conference in Victoria in 1981, then attended the State Meet in the Spring of 1982. He officially started as a Contest Co-Director in September of 1982.

"I worked with John until about 1995, when he retired both from the University and the Contest," he said. "I am pretty sure that now, after 42 years, I am the longest serving UIL state director. I may be the longest serving person in the UIL."

Former UIL Academics Director Bobby Hawthorne said Bourell never complained about the travel or the little pay.

"You have to remember that he was being flown back and forth to Europe to work on bridge projects. He was paid handsomely to do it, and he was paid little or nothing to direct the calculator contest," Hawthorne said. "He's remained in this position for three decades because he believes in the kids who compete and the men and women who coach those kids. I have been fortunate to know him as a colleague, a friend and a fan."
