# **Executive Board** meets in June

The TMSCA Executive Board met in Dallas on June 22.

# A. Action Item: Approval of minutes - The Board reviewed the minutes from the March 14 Executive Board meeting. Sammy made a motion the minutes be approved as read, and following a second by Steve, the minutes were approved.

## C. Reports: Directors and Liaison Reports

1. High School Director Report - Josh Newton reported that splitting the grading room into Number Sense and Calculator sections helped. The pre-grading by UTSA volunteers helped with the Math and Science tests. Ways to streamline the grading of calculator tests needs to be considered.

2. Middle School Director Report – Sammy Wyatt, middle school director, reported on problems with the calculator test (a page being backwards) and the number sense test (wrong answers due to the writer changing the test after it was proofed). Positive point was there were less DQs. Discussion for improvement included pre-grading the calculator test, staying with the check-

# A synopsis of TMSCA's 4 contests

#### **Number Sense**

Number Sense involves a 10-minute, 80-question mental math test covering all high school mathematics courses. Shortcuts need to be developed and practiced in order to compete and finish the test.

#### **Science**

This contest challenges students to do a wide range of reading in biology, chemistry and physics, to gain an understanding of the significance of experiments rather than to recall details, to be alert to new discoveries and information in the areas of science, to gain an understanding of the basic principles as well as knowledge of the history and philosophy of science, and to foster a sense of enthusiasm about how science affects our lives.

#### **Calculator Applications**

This contest includes calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, roots, powers, exponential, logarithms, trigonometric functions and inverse trigonometric functions. In addition to straightfor-

ward calculation problems, the contest includes geometric and stated problems similar to those found in algebra, geometry and trigonometry textbooks, previous contests and League materials related to the contest.

#### **Mathematics**

This contest is designed to test knowledge and understanding in the areas of algebra I and algebra II, geometry, trigonometry, math analysis, analytic geometry, precalculus and elementary calculus.

suggestions to fill the needed positions.

Due to confusion and the fact that TMSCA is a trademark, a group using TMSCA in their name pulled the website immediately when contacted.

Online meet income is up this year.

- 5. State Meets Coordinator Report Joan Naylor reported Zach Sharon will replace Dr. Patterson as the UTSA sponsor. Both a "check-in" and "check-out" for UTSA persons will be reinstated next year. Volunteers need their duties explained in detail to alleviate confusion. The "Quiet" shirts seemed to be effective. Ballroom 2 for awards this year was new and needs to be booked again.
- 6. UIL Liaison Report Cliff McCurdy reported. Bixler has chosen the Science book for next year's tests: "How to Teach Quantum Physics to Your Dog." An announcement at Capital Conference regarding the TI-30 Calculators is expected. HP Prime triangle solver can be modified to solve circle problems as well.

Michelle Randall will try to get the written proposal to the UIL Legislative Council regarding the combining of the Science I and Science II tests.

D. Action Item: Board of Regents – After discussion, a motion was made to add \$750 to the publicity line item in the budget for promotional materials to be sent to each of the Board of Regents to help promote TMSCA. The motion was made by Sammy and seconded by Carol. Motion was approved.

- **E. Action Item: Bank Account** After discussion, Sammy made a motion that we purchase a CD for one year at the bank holding TMSCA funds with designated signatories being the President, President-Elect and the Secretary; motion carried.
- **F.** Actions Item: Stipend Amount for Extra Duty Currently. TMSCA charges schools \$150 for working meets, and presenters/workers are paid \$100. A

motion was made by Sammy to increase the stipend amount paid for presentation and in-service workers to \$200 but to leave the TMSCA charge to schools at \$150. After a second by Josh, motion carried.

#### **G. Discussion Items:**

- 1. Splitting 5A into big and small schools for qualifying scores. TMSCA policy classifies Middle Schools by the High School into which they feed. There is a large discrepancy in the sizes of 5A schools. After discussion, a solution might be to consider separating 5A and 6A qualifying scores instead of them being the same.
- 2. Changing the order of tests during the state meets. Five different options were submitted for considerations. After discussion, it seems the shortage of graders is the problem, and enlisting High School students to pregrade at the Middle school State Meet and training volunteers at the High School State Meet (or using former Calculator students to grade) would resolve the issue.
- **H. Action Item: Calendar** Tentative calendar was already approved. Since UIL made no changes to its calendar, no action was required.
- I. Action Item: 2019-2020 Budget The Board reviewed the proposed budget for the 2019-2020 year. Michelle made a motion that the budget be approved as discussed, and, following a second by Carol, the budget was ap-
- **J. Other Items of Business** There were no other items of business.

K. Action Item: Adjournment – At 1 p.m., Josh made a motion that the meeting adjourn. Following a second by Sammy, the meeting was adjourned. The next TMSCA Executive Board meeting will be in Dallas on Dec. 14.
