# TMSCA Executive Board meets June 20 in Dallas

Members present: Andy Zapata, President-Elect; Steve Holmes, Treasurer; Luonna Adkins, High School Director; Joan Naylor, Middle School Director; Kendra Bates, Recording Secretary; Frances Renfroe, Bookkeeper; and Julie Majewski-Smith, Executive Director.

The following items were discussed and approved for the 2015-2016 school year:

Permission to Represent Form (for parents/sponsors whose children attend a non-TMSCA member school) - Due to the large number of parents/ volunteers requesting to be allowed to coach their children under the auspices of a non-TMSCA member school. the Board adopted a policy that reads as follows: "TMSCA requires parent/ representatives of students attending a non-TMSCA member school to submit the Permission to Represent Form signed by the principal of the child's school prior to issuance of a school membership to the parent/representative."

Elementary Test Pool – Due to low sales of the elementary test pools over the past two years, a motion was passed to discontinue the annual writing of the elementary test sets, but to continue to sell the two test pools we have already written.

High School Calculator Test Writer Requirement – In order to provide a better product for our coaches, we are now requiring the HS Calculator test writer to furnish solutions for ALL stated and geometry problems.

Middle School Math Test Writer Requirement - It was proposed that we require more complete selected solutions in order to provide a better product for our coaches on the middle school math tests. Accordingly, the salary would be adjusted for this new requirement. Following a discussion, the Board decided to table this issue until the December meeting.

Proposed '15-'16 Calendar - The 2015-2016 was presented with the high school state meet set for March 19, 2016, and the middle school state meet set for April 16, 2016, with an alternate date of April 9, pending approval from UTSA. Dates for online meets and tournament release dates were also discussed. The calendar was approved as presented.

Contingency plan for bad weather for qualifying meets - The Board approved a policy for a contingency plan in case of bad weather during the middle school state qualifying meets. In the event of the cancellation(s) of qualifying meets, we will have an "emergency test" that can be given on an assigned date and time, as designated by the Executive Director and the middle school directors. If necessary, meets may be moved to alternate locations as long as a minimum of two schools are in attendance at these alternate sites.

Use of the TMSCA computer program for Invitational meets - A policy was adopted to allow TMSCA to use its resources to run an invitational meet with an expense allowance of up to \$100 per meet. Expenses exceeding \$100 will be charged to the host school. Availability will be on a first come, first served basis, contingent on availability of TMSCA staff and resources

Minimum number of schools requirement for individual qualifying meets – A policy was passed that stated for the two <u>individual</u> state qualifying meets, it is required that a minimum of three schools be in attendance in order for the results of that meet to be valid.

Adjournment - The next Executive Board meeting will be on Saturday, Dec. 12 in Dallas.



# TMSCA officers attend Capital Conference in Austin

UIL hosted its annual Capital Conference June 29- 30 in Austin. The conference had a new home this year, the AT&T Executive Education and Conference Center. It featured great facilities for both the sessions presented at the conference and an expanded area for the vendors.

Dr. David Stevens, UIL Academic Director, reported there were 845 registered attendees. Over 60 schools were represented, along with 10 vendors.

Sessions for all academic contests were presented by UIL Contest Directors and some of the most renowned coaches of all UIL events from across the state. Presenters of sessions of particular interest to TMSCA members included Larry White, UIL Math and Numbers Sense Contest Director, and Andy Zapata, UIL Consultant and test writer for UIL A+ Calculator, Number Sense and Mathematics.

TMSCA hosted a booth which gave participants a chance to view our materials and learn about the benefits of being a TMSCA member. The booth was visited by over 200 interested coaches and administrators.

Coaches and sponsors of UIL events who have not had the opportunity to attend the annual Capital Conferences are encouraged to make plans early to attend next year. For any UIL/ TMSCA coach, novice or experienced, this conference will prove invaluable.





### A synopsis of TMSCA's 4 contests

#### **Number Sense**

Number Sense involves a 10-minute, 80-question mental math test covering all high school mathematics courses. Shortcuts need to be developed and practiced in order to compete and finish the test.

#### Science

This contest challenges students to do a wide range of reading in biology, chemistry and physics, to gain an understanding of the significance of experiments rather than to recall details, to be alert to new discoveries and information in the areas of science, to gain an understanding of the basic principles as well as knowledge of the history and philosophy of science, and to foster a sense of enthusiasm about how science affects our lives.

#### **Calculator Applications**

This contest includes calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, roots, powers, exponential, logarithms, trigonometric functions and inverse trigonometric functions. In addition to straightforward calculation problems, the contest includes geometric and stated problems similar to those found in algebra, geometry and trigonometry textbooks, previous contests and League materials related to the contest.

#### **Mathematics**

This contest is designed to test knowledge and understanding in the areas of algebra I and algebra II, geometry, trigonometry, math analysis, analytic geometry, precalculus and elementary calculus.
